The following was discussed

1. KW Intergroup primary mission: Maintain hotline, Maintain website, Print schedules and provide pamphlets free of charge and books to meetings at cost (except the Jails and DeePoo)
2. Paul L.: Depoo Cafeteria meetings (Fellowship Group) Monday 6pm and Sunday 530pm need to come off the schedule. Downtown group is moving from St. Pauls to Old Stone Church on 1 April
3. Haven Greene: (treasurer)/(Shen: Committee member); Two checks were deposited \$175 from the Mid keys group and \$50 from the New Beginnings Group. Balance as of 28 Feb is \$834 +\$225 =\$1,079 dollars. Expense this period were for the Phone (\$121) and a \$5 bank service charge. Paul H. reported there is a problem with the debit card. Birch and Haven will visit the bank this week to resolve . Motion was made for Haven to take over duties as treasurer. Motion passed.
4. Paul H. (literature): No purchases this period. Will order more pamphlets. Cost is minimal. Will report at next meeting. Literature rack at the club is full...need to check on rack at Care Center and Hospital. Depoo has requested Daily Reflections and Living Sober literature
5. Paul H. (Phone): Phone is working. Adi called and Counter Gary answered
6. Paul H. Last print was in August. Next print will most likely be April. Some discussion on what information to put in the 'District Box' on the cover. Current thinking is to add a note that for information on Jail meetings, send a note via the AAfloridakeys website. Shen has picked sunshine orange
7. Men's Jail meeting: Adi reported that procedure for clearance is fingerprinting, submit application and a 1 hour (?) orientation. She believes they will do orientation (Men and women are done at the same time) once 5 people sign up. Men may be able to restart but we need to ask. Meetings are held Monday and Wednesday and attendees may need to plan on being there from 7:30pm to 9:30pm. Current 3 women are active doing the jail meetings. Support is needed
8. Depoo: Jackie reported that she has been able to get people to chair the meetings. She normally gets 2 people to run the meetings and fills her calendar 30 days out

10. Guidance Clinic: Still trying to get a POC for the Marathon Guidance Clinic
