The following was discussed

1. KW Intergroup primary mission: Maintain hotline, Maintain website, Print schedules and provide pamphlets free of charge and books to meetings at cost (except the Jails and DeePoo)
2. Paul L.: Depoo Cafeteria meetings (Fellowship Group) needs to come off the online schedule. It was noted that the "Meeting APP" takes a few days to update
3. Haven Greene: (treasurer): No report. As of 5 May, the balance was \$647 dollars.
4. Paul H. (literature): No purchases this period. Will order more pamphlets. Cost is minimal. Will report at next meeting.
5. Paul H. (Phone): Phone is working. We have a new phone service that is \$30 dollars cheaper per month. Shen tested and the intro for the service needs to be changed. 7. Men's Jail meeting: Adi reported that procedure for clearance is fingerprinting, submitting application and a 1 hour (?) orientation. She believes they will do orientation (Men and women are done at the same time). Men may be able to restart but we need to ask. Meetings are held Monday and Wednesday and attendees may need to plan on being there from 7:30pm to 9:30pm. Current 8 women are active doing the jail meetings. All men are required to redo orientation. No update
8. Depoo: No report
9. KOTS Meeting: Haig is helping Gary run the meeting. Meeting is restricted on who from the outside may attend. No update
10. Guidance Clinic: Still trying to get a POC for the Marathon Guidance Clinic. Shen will try to locate
11. District 11/Area 15: Area GSRs are Birch O., Ash and Betina. Shen indicated that Area may have fundings for literature for H&I meeting

Post meeting notes with information provided by Shen

1. Marathon Guidance Clinic: They have 19 beds and intake is via baker act or voluntary. Assessment done on intake to evaluate with detox should be at the hospital. Long term treatment is done on the mainland. A mobile crises response team has been set up

2. Depoo has 25 beds with a similar operation as the Marathon Guidance.
