The following was discussed

1. KW Intergroup primary mission: Maintain hotline, Maintain website, Print schedules and provide pamphlets free of charge and books to meetings at cost (except the Jails and DeePoo)
2. Paul L.: Website is up to date with MOM and meeting schedule. Paul stated that we currently have 1 year of MOM posted. A motion was made to remove old minutes except for the current 3 months. Motion passed
3. Haven Greene: (treasurer): Contributions received from FOBW (\$400) and Southernmost Group (\$320). Bank balance is \$1968 dollars. No report on expenses.
4. Paul H. (literature): Motion was made to allow Paul to purchase \$800 dollars of literature as needed. Women's Jail has requested 12x12s. Motion passed
5. Paul H. (Phone): Phone was checked prior to the meeting and is working. Shen has taken over management of the phone system and will tweet the Key West answering service
6. Paul H. New schedule was released in April. Next schedule print is late summer
7. Men's Jail meeting: Adi reported that procedure for clearance is fingerprinting, submitting application and a 1 hour (?) orientation. She believes they will do orientation (Men and women are done at the same time). Men may be able to restart but we need to ask. Meetings are held Monday and Wednesday and attendees may need to plan on being there from 7:30pm to 9:30pm. Current 8 women are active doing the jail meetings. All men are required to redo orientation. Dan D. will research status of men's meeting and report back next month/
8. Depoo: Jackie stated that meeting are held every evening at 6[, and 2 people from the outside are requested to chair meeting. One year of sobriety is needed. Asked that the need for chairpersons be announced at meetings.
9. KOTS Meeting: Haig is helping Gary run the meeting. Meeting is restricted on whom from the outside may attend. No update
